Annual Election of Officers: Larry Weed moved that we accept the slate of officers nominated at the November meeting; Bill Poteat seconded. The officers were elected by acclimation.

The club's normal department reports were suspended in order to provide time for preparing the layout and museum for the Valdese Christmas Parade.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:08 PM by Tim Skidmore.
